



## KOHAN REFLECTION GARDEN 2021 COVID-19 EVENT SAFETY PLAN

### Kohan Reflection Garden use by the Public

- The Garden, as a Village of New Denver public park, is open to all visitors.
- Gatherings and events are allowed only at the discretion of the Society's Board of Directors and the Village of New Denver.
- The Society will follow current provincial COVID-19 safety guidelines.
- General safety requirements for ALL users
  - Do not enter if you are sick or required to quarantine; please do a Health Check prior to entering the garden
  - Physical distancing required
  - Masks are required if physical distancing is not possible
  - Pay attention to COVID-19 signage

### Safety Plan for Maintenance Work Party Volunteers and Contract Workers:

- Volunteers/workers come and go on their own schedule; there are usually never more than 5 persons working in the Garden at one time (except at bi-annual work parties which have a separate safety plan).
- Volunteers/workers sign-in their hours and if they are not a SLGS member, they need to leave their phone number for contact tracing (retained for 30 days).
- Volunteers/workers should bring their own safety/PPE, (masks, gloves, sanitizers) or use the ones provided on the site. Masks and other PPE can be found in the Garden's tool shed.
- All work in the Kohan Reflection Garden is done outdoors. Volunteers/workers are able to continue with their tasks with appropriate social distancing (2m. or 6'). Volunteers/workers are entitled to ask others to respect their need for a social distance. If there are uncomfortable incidents, they should contact a SLGS Board Member or the VND.

### Events, Weddings, Classes, Tours.

- Please check provincial guidelines for updates on public gatherings and travel restrictions for the date of your event.
- Event organizers will write a COVID-19 Safety Plan specific to their event, in coordination with their SLGS liaison person.
- Event organizers need to provide a contact tracing sign-in sheet with first name and phone number for each participant at the event (to be kept for 30 days only).

### Food Preparation and serving:

- Refreshments will be prepared by a caterer who will use COVID-19 food service safety protocols.
- All foods will be dispensed in individual portions by a masked and gloved server.
- Extra seating will be made available to ensure appropriate physical distancing.
