IRRIGATION SYSTEM

The Village of New Denver works crew manages seasonal maintenance and repairs of the irrigation system.

Spring: the system is turned on and checked for leaks and needed repairs.

Fall: the system is shut off and winterized.

Operation notes:

- A map of the irrigation lines and sprinkler heads is kept in the tool shed.
- The keys for the electrical boxes and the timer are with the maps.
- The irrigation timer is in a smaller grey panel box, labelled with the brand name "HUNTER".
- The timer will not run unless the panel switch is 'on'. This will be turned 'off' each Fall.
- Generally, the sprinkling times are for one half hour for each zone, 3X/wk. at 4am. There are 7 zones.
- The schedule and dates to start and end are decided by a Board member, according to prevailing weather.
- Workers and Volunteers need to be alert to leaks or malfunctioning sprinkler heads and must monitor that soil, mulch or plant material are not obstructing sprinkler heads.
- Any problems need to go to VND through the SLGS liaison.
